 learning outcomes .




The focus of School Library

"Celebrate the understood, not the found"




 It actively supports the curriculum providing of up-todate related resources, in collaboration with classroom teachers.

- 1. Is knowledgeable about content area curriculum standards.
- 2. Actively participates in curriculum development.
- 3. Promotes reading.
- 4. Meets, plans, and collaborates with classroom teachers.
- 5. Teaches students how to access, evaluate, and use information.



- 6. Trains teachers in the use of information technology.
- 7. Promotes ethical and responsible use of information.
- 8. Takes an active role in the instructional program of the school.
- 9. Effectively manages the library collection and library program to make it an integral part of the school.
- 10.Positively impacts student achievement.
